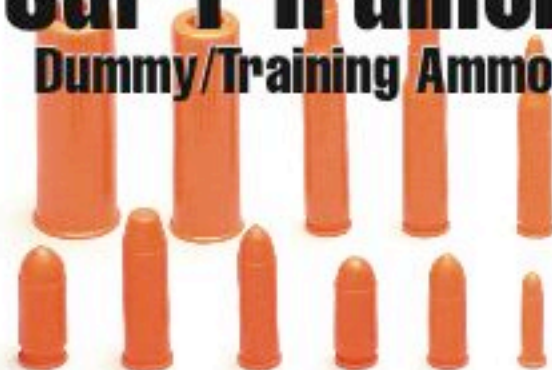

dramatic. The 2-1/2" .410 shell carries a half-ounce shot charge and, when aimed at the sternum area of a standard police silhouette target seven yards distant, about 110 #6 pellets are nicely distributed from the forehead to the crotch. Penetration would not be lethal, but the resultant pain and bleeding would certainly get someone's attention. And if needed, the second round, a .45 Colt, would permanently end the discussion. The shell loaded with #4 shot contains about 66 pellets. Close up, it makes a nasty mess; at five yards, it will still put an attacker in a world of hurt.

Triple-0 buck, in a 2-1/2" .410 load, comprises three .36 caliber balls. These seemed to cluster fairly well close up, and would undoubtedly make a lasting impression.

Firing five .45 Colt cartridges at five to seven yards, I easily achieved a satisfyingly tight off-hand group. The trigger pull, in single-action

mode, was a very nice 4-1/2 pounds. Double-action pull was around 12 pounds and quite smooth and manageable. I had been concerned that a bore designed for both shot and a conventional bullet might not be totally satisfactory for either or both, but the results showed that the Judge was master of both types of projectile.

I had thought that the .410 shotshell might be a bit of a handful in a revolver, even though it's considered a pipsqueak load in a shotgun. However, as I had noticed with my friend's .45 Tracker, the Ribber Grips did an impressive job of smoothing out the recoil. With .410 or .45 Colt, the Judge is a pleasure to shoot. If you do need a good reason to purchase yet another handgun, here are three: The Taurus Judge is a versatile and formidable defense gun, it's an incomparable fun gun and it's a pretty sure bet you don't already have one like it!
