





There once was an individual in our suburban retirement community who made his living by defrauding widows of their late husbands' gun collections... "I can give you one hundred dollars for that old, worn Colt Single Action," etc., etc. I can happily report that he passed away some years ago from a slow, painful ailment. Anyway, it makes an important point for those of us who have spent our hard-earned cash on some valuable guns: You're not going to live forever, and your survivors can benefit greatly from a detailed record of your collection, and an updated accounting of each gun's significance and value.

Years ago, I started keeping such a record on index cards. I wrote down all pertinent details such as manufacturer, model, caliber, serial number, finish, accessories, price paid, *Blue Book* value, etc. Initially, I had recorded such data as what I'd paid or traded for the gun, where I obtained it, etc., but later I realized that this information has no real relevance in making future decisions. As the collection grew, I transferred the information to pages in a 3-ring binder. In the early 1980s, when I reluctantly transitioned into the digital age, I found a simple database program for my Apple IIc that enabled me to store the information on floppy disks (remember

those?). Some years later, while using a succession of Macs, I took advantage of Apple's excellent – and exceedingly simple – AppleWorks database, which even allowed me to include photos of each one of my guns. This is a valuable feature, especially if you have heirs who wouldn't know a GLOCK from a glockenspiel.

A couple of years ago, my MacBook started showing signs of senile dementia, so I went to

the Apple Store and acquired a new desktop Mac, a delightful contraption with a large screen and all sorts of modern bells and whistles. While transferring all my files from the MacBook, I learned that Apple "no longer supported" Apple-Works, and that my database would not function on the new Mac. No problem, I thought, I'll just transfer all my gun records and photos to Apple's replacement database. Further research revealed that there was no such replacement database. Checking with my computer-savvy son-in-law, I discovered that any available database program would be of such complexity that I'd need a livein IT specialist to manage it, and my heirs might find it incomprehensible. No thank you.

The good news was, my old MacBook was still sufficiently usable that I could print out all my existing files, along with appropriate photos. I put each page in a plastic sleeve, with room for owner's manual and any accompanying documentation, and arranged them alphabetically in 3-ring binders...very low-tech and easily accessible to my survivors.

The basic information is obvious. You'll need a good photo of each gun, so every piece in the collection will be easily recognizable, even to someone with no particular firearms knowledge. List make, model, serial number, caliber, barrel length, finish, accompanying accessories, etc. It's also useful to include any information that would justify the value that you place on the gun, such as historical or family background, i.e. "This is the 1911A1 that Grandpa Fred carried at Bastogne during World War II," or "This was my first .22 rifle, and I want it passed down to so-and-so when he's old enough to be responsible with it."

Placing a value on each item can be a challenge. The current Blue Book of Gun Values can be very helpful, but it is not the be-all and end-

all authority, especially where there might be regional differences. Check Gunbroker.com and other on-line resources, but be aware that these marketplaces are the last refuge of eternal optimists. Always check to see how many bids there are on a gun that has a high starting price. Zero bids close to the end date indicate that the seller has an unduly optimistic view of the gun's value. One possible approach to take is, if you had to sell your gun tomorrow, how much would you settle for? Add 10- to 15-percent for bargaining, and that's your number.

Be aware of some legal hurdles. Any NFA items... selective fire or full-auto weapons, silencers, shortbarreled rifles, etc., will require getting competent professional legal advice. Guns made before 1898 are not regarded as firearms by the feds, but your local authorities may have different ideas on the subject. Guns with no serial numbers may have been made before the Gun Control Act of 1968, or may be "Lunch Box Specials," snuck out of the factory one piece at a time by employees. Guns with the serial number deliberately removed are illegal. Destroy them. You don't want to inflict that

potential grief on your family.

One parting thought: If you have any duplicate guns or ones you haven't used for years, you might want to donate them to deserving young friends or relatives while you're still on this side of grass. You'll be able to see them enjoy the gift and, best

Capable of loading over 160 calibers – just like the RL 550 – it uses any manufacturer's standard 7/8" x 14 reloading dies. It's priced comparably with other manufacturers' turret presses; yet unlike them, it's fully upgradeable to Dillon's Progressive RL 550 loader!

The interchangeable toolhead (*Page 15*) makes it quick, easy and inexpensive to change calibers. For example, if you load .30-06 for elk, .243 for deer and .22-250 for coyotes, you don't even have to change the shellplate. You simply pull two pins and swap the toolhead with your .30-06 dies to another toolhead with your .22-250 or .243 dies in less than 30 seconds! The additional toolheads are \$22.95 each, or \$20.95 each if you buy three or more – if you load for several rifles it's a no-brainer! Once you get your dies adjusted, you'll never have to re-set them.

A powder measure adapter (bottom right photo) is available if you want to use a manual measure that you already own. Or, if you want to weigh every powder charge you load, it's easy – you can use a powder trickler with the powder die/funnel assembly that comes with the BL 550.

Taper Crimp Die

The taper crimp die is also specially configured to center both the case neck and the case body, thereby aligning the entire cartridge for a more uniform crimp. Dillon Rifle Dies are designed to meet the more rigid requirements for both accuracy and precision demanded by today's marksman.

A taper crimp die is preferred for loading ammunition intended to be used in semiautomatic firearms with detachable box magazines, and in lever-action firearms with tubular magazines.



36 Shining Some Light on Hand

Within the shooting community there's some disagreement (Shocking, I know!) about handheld lights and weapon lights. One camp, I'll call the "JEL" (just-enough-lumens) camp and the other, the "ATL" (all-the-lumens) camp. The JEL camp is all about having "just enough lumens to not blind thyself but enough to do the job." The ATL camp is firmly of the belief that we need all the lumens possible; in fact, I'm pretty sure some of these folks would pocket carry the sun if they could. To help clarify some things, I thought it would be helpful to explore the subject here.

First let's visit the "lumen," which is – in essence – a functional measure of a light's intensity, or total brightness output at a given distance. That definition is as simplified by Aaron Cowan of Sage Dynamics (www.sagedynamics.org) due to the Webster's version being nearly indecipherable for the layman. "Lux" is lumens per square meter and the sun produces around 98,000 Lux. Last, for this section we have the "candela," the measure of the intensity of the beam at a focused point. Now, why on earth flashlight and weapon light manufacturers insist on using lumens as their unit of measurement instead of the more-useful candela is beyond me.

Another consideration is the ambient light. Photopic light is daylight or environments with a lot of ambient light, such as an illuminated football stadium. Full darkness is called scotopic light and is generally regarded as being from an hour after sunset to an hour before sunrise though, obviously, the amount of light provided by the moon can be a factor as well. Between


these two, we have mesopic light, which you would find just before sunrise or just after sunset. Environmental lighting such as low-pressure sodium streetlights and yard lights would also be considered mesopic lighting.

With that out of the way, let's look at the JEL camp's position. They're of the opinion that they want just enough light for the occasion. Sometimes you'll hear statements along the lines of, "Well, I can't justify engaging a threat beyond 10 yards." One of the other concerns cited is that too much light being reflected back from to a white wall or mirror will blind them. On the surface, these seem like perfectly reasonable concerns. Many times, the result of these concerns is opting for a compact weapon light such as a Crimson Trace Lightguard (www.crimsontrace.com) or Surefire XC1 (www.surefire.com). Other times it may be in the form of a more-compact flashlight.

Contrasting with the JEL camp is the All-The-Lumens or ATL camp. Their contention is that you want as much light as possible. Their reasoning is that you don't get to pick when and where you'll need your light. It's one thing if you only need it inside a home with small rooms and/or short hallways; it's another if you're dealing with larger structures, the outdoors, or with varying amounts of mesopic and scotopic light. It's possible that you may have to shine a light through a well-lit area to illuminate something in the shadows and this can require power to do. Another consideration is if you need to effectively reach past 10 or so yards. Their response to the "too much light" concern is to employ techniques to avoid it.

held and Weapon Light Use







In the interest of full disclosure, I was once a member of the JEL camp. After some training through instructors like Travis Haley of Haley Strategic (www.haleystrategic.com) and Matt Graham of Graham Combat (www.grahamtradecraft. com) as well as discussions with Bill Blowers of Tap Rack Tactical (www.tap-rack.com) and Aaron Cowan of Sage Dynamics, I joined the ranks of the ATL camp. As readers of *The Blue Press* may remember from a previous article, it was while training with Graham Combat that I came to the conclusion that my XC1 Weapon Light was less than adequate for my needs, and I promptly went back to an X300 Ultra. For those who missed it, what happened was that I was shining the light down a hallway that was probably 10 yards long. At the end of the hallway was an open door. I was sure there was a threat with his back to the wall in line with the door, but the light didn't have enough power – despite its fresh battery – to overcome the full light of the hallway and still manage to provide any useful light inside that room. This led me to the conclusion that the XC1 may be fine inside a small house or apartment in near darkness, but really wasn't up to outdoors, mixed light, or larger buildings. In the case of the XC1, the beam pattern has more spread and has less reach, so that's a consideration as well. Oh, and that room I thought had a threat in it...yeah, there was a threat in that room exactly where I thought it was. This was particularly concerning to me as I live in a single-story home that has a bit of distance from one end to the other.

So now that we've looked at both, one may wonder about techniques for using more-powerful

lights. The concern about reflection expressed by the JEL camp can be used as a tool rather than avoided. Instead of shining the light straight at a surface and possibly having our vision overcome by the light, we can use that reflection as a tool. The way to do this is to point the light in a more upward or downward direction and "bounce" the light onto the surface. In general, the darker the surface, the less the light it will reflect. Carpet doesn't reflect very well, so you may have to employ a muzzle-up position for the use of a weapon-mounted light.

Another issue of particular concern with a weapon light is: wherever you point the light, so goes the muzzle. Bill Blowers of Tap Rack Tactical pointed out that he isn't comfortable with muzzling every non-LE person in a building, particularly children, so he prefers to drop the muzzle or go muzzle high depending on the situation. This may be a consideration for the concealed carrier or home defender as pointing a gun at a family member is generally considered poor form.

In the end, I totally understand the appeal of the smaller lights, as they tend to take up less space on one's body, particularly the small weapon lights, making them easy to carry on a concealed-carry pistol. It is just my belief that if you are making that selection, you need to understand the limitations and be prepared to deal with them. Similarly, knowing how to employ the brighter lights is also a good plan.







CLASSIC FIREARMS: The Smith

By John Marshall

From the 19-teens through the 1960s, most law enforcement agencies in the United States were issuing or specifying revolvers rather than semiauto pistols to their officers. Most of these were chambered for the .38 Special cartridge, or since 1935, its big brother, the .357 Magnum. One of the most sought-after revolvers among both police and civilians was the Smith & Wesson Combat Magnum. Available in either blue or nickel finish, it was introduced in 1955 on the recommendation of

shooting expert and Border Patrol Assistant Chief Patrol Inspector Bill Jordan. In 1957, it became designated as the Model 19. This mediumframe revolver could handle either .357 Magnum or .38 Special loads. The 36-ounce Model 19 offered a substantial weight saving over Smith's large-frame guns, the

Models 27 and 28. It was almost the perfect .357 revolver, and way more than a few found berths on police duty belts.

But Smith & Wesson was endeavoring to go the Model 19 one better, designing a revolver that would make a great gun even greater. The added marketing lure of providing virtually the same gun made from stainless steel intrigued the management, and they went to work to solve the problems of metallurgy and tooling that would make it a reality. S&W had introduced its first stainless steel gun, the small-frame .38 Special Model 60 revolver, in 1965. It was immediately popular as an undercover and backup gun with police forces, and civilians clamored for it as well. It became obvious that stainless guns had immense appeal in the marketplace, and S&W sought to broaden the concept. So on May 5, 1970, the very first Stainless Combat Magnum was made, carrying serial number K949100. It took Smith & Wesson a while longer to work out all the details for mass production, so the new Model 66 was not formally announced until July 8, 1971. A rust-resistant version of the famed Model 19 had become a reality!

These first guns were made not only as utilitarian tools, but visually they were works of art. The finish was nice matte rather than highly polished. The non-tapered barrels were carefully indexed by hand at the factory and then pinned in place. The cylinders had counter-bored chambers to accept the cartridge rims, allowing the back of the cylinder to closely match up to the recoil shield. A choice of service or target stocks was offered – the latter came in two styles, checkered or smooth "presentation" style. Wider "target" triggers and

hammers were options. The extractor rod was shrouded for protection against damage. The standard front sight had a red insert, and the rear sight leaf could be either plain black or equipped with a white outline around the notch. The first rear sight bodies and mounting tangs were stainless, but later were changed to blackened tool steel. A standard feature was an adjustable trigger override stop that gave a very precise single-action trigger pull letoff. In those days, the actions were hand-fitted to perfection, and the double-action trigger pull was

smooth and uniform.

SMITH &WESSON

The first barrel length provided was 4", a popular length that was a nice compromise for sighting, velocity and carrying ease. A round-butt 2-1/2"-barreled version became available in 1974 and became favored for discreet carry. In 1978, a 6" barrel became a cataloged option, recognizing that in some instances, the gun might be used for longer dis-

The 66 went through some changes over the years, and the major changes were signified by an added dash and a number stamped in the yoke recess. For example, the revolver pictured, shipped in 1978, is a Model 66-1 ("dash one"), where the main change in 1977 was the relocation of the gas ring from the yoke to the cylinder. The 66-1 was also notable as it was

pass. The final one was the 66-6, which introduced the controversial and nearly universally despised internal key lock system in 2002. In 2005, the Model 66 was dropped from the S&W catalog. It had been supplanted and later replaced by the beefed-up Model 686 in 1980, which was both easier on the hand and arguably more durable with extended shooting of stout .357 loads. A revolver "re-introduced" and billed as the Model 66-8 came about in 2014, but having a less-attractive frame profile, a floating firing pin located in the frame instead of on the hammer, an internal key lock and a shrouded two-piece barrel, it is a far cry from the svelte and elegant Model 66s of the past.

In my opinion, the early Model 66-4 was really the last "traditional" variation. Later iterations seemed to have abandoned sophistication and quality as a sacrifice on the altar of fast production. For collectors and those who appreciate fine revolvers, the pinned and recessed "no dash" and "dash one" guns rule the roost for desirability. If in great condition, one of these will bring a premium when found.

norm for police use in the 1980s, revolvers in general lost ground in popularity. The increased ammunition capacity of the semiautos and the ability to accomplish fast high-capacity magazine reloads brought the curtain down on most revolvers. The main exceptions were some large-bores and the smaller backup and concealment guns. However, for those who appreciate the traditional beauty and reliability of fine wheel guns, the Model 66 still stands very tall in the pack. The smoothness of the action easily surpasses that of the larger Model 686, which replaced it in the S&W lineup. The trigger pull is a dream in either double- or single-action, definitely beating any of the current crop of plastic-framed wonder guns. In short, it was a near-ideal selfdefense and trail gun that was simple, quick to bring into action, extremely reli-

able, accurate, versatile and easy to learn. It was near the pinnacle of service revolvers as made by Smith & Wesson, and the demand for good examples has only increased in recent years. For traditionalists such as I admit to being, the 66 is a beautiful classic and a definite keeper.

Loading Pla

Many people choose plated bullets to handload, since they cost less than jacketed, but don't cause barrel leading. Problem: most people can't load such bullets so they shoot accurately. Simply using the same procedures we can get away with, when using jacketed bullets or even hard-cast lead, and thinking that will transition over to plated bullets will not work. Ask me how I know. At first I figured, no problem, I would simply consult that unfailing source of at-your-fingertips information, the Internet. Only to find that sometimes the Internet does fail. There is absolutely no good information on the 'net re how to load plated bullets so they'll shoot accurately. I say that as someone who's already tried, at length, to find it. Thus, I had to figure this all out for myself. Eventually I did. I can now load ammo with plated bullets that shoots accurately, in my two most frequently fired cartridges, 9mm Parabellum and .45 ACP. In this article, I will share with you what I've learned.

There are three important areas where we need to pay attention if we want to load accurate plated-bullet ammo: (1) choose the right bullet, (2) case flaring, (3) crimp. Neglect any of these areas and our groups with plated bullets will look like long-range shotgun patterns.

CHOOSE THE RIGHT BULLET

To start with, we need to understand a few things about plated bullets, and why they're so much harder to load and produce accurate ammunition than jacketed or hard-cast lead. As a cost-cutting measure, and a huge reason plated bullets




As part of checking crimp, begin by inserting the cartridge casing into the case gage backward, to ensure its rim will fit completely into the gage.

are less expensive than jacketed, they're made with a soft lead-wire core. Then in order to avoid barrel leading, they cover that with plating. Thing is, the plating isn't nearly as thick as a bullet jacket, therefore not nearly as strong or resistant to deformation. So we've got dead-soft lead covered with a thin, fragile coating. We need to take that into account, because if we don't, we will deform bullets during the handloading process. Deformed bullets will not shoot accurately.

Typical thickness of a bullet jacket is .011" to .012". Typical thickness of bullet plating is .003" to .004". In other words, we're only getting a third of the deformation protection from plating as from a true bullet jacket. However, we also have "double plated" a.k.a. "thick plated" bullets, on which the plating goes .007" to .008". While the plating on these bullets still isn't nearly as thick as a bullet jacket, it's a lot thicker than the typical single-plated bullet.

We have three major producers of plated bullets these days: Rainier Ballistics, Berry's and X-treme. In 9mm (the classic "fast" autopistol cartridge), Rainier Ballistics does not offer thick-plated bullets per se, however they do offer thick-plated bullets

in .38 Super which work perfectly in 9mm. I have run many, many of these down the barrels of various 9mms over the years. Berry's offers both single-plated and thick-plated bullets; just look for "TP" (Thick Plate) as a suffix to the bullet name. X-treme thick plates all their bullets, period.

If we're firing a subsonic load (the classic "slow" autopistol cartridge being, of course, .45 ACP), in my experience we don't actually need thick plating. As long as we're doing everything else right, we can get good accuracy with single plated at such low velocities. Nor is thick plating really necessary in a subsonic load in 9mm, i.e. if we're running 147-grain bullets. But when we start talking projectile velocities over 1,000 feet per second, for instance we're trying to make Minor power factor in 9mm with 115-grain or 124-grain bullets, that's when we absolutely need thick-plated bullets to get good accuracy.

CASE FLARING

At the powder drop/case flaring station, we need to flare the casing to accept the bullet considerably more with plated bullets than we would with jacketed or hard-cast lead. It would be impossible to overstate the importance of this.

Of course, with harder and/or jacketed bullets we don't really like to flare the case mouth very much, because that can weaken the case mouth, and eventually, after multiple loadings, it'll split during the loading process. With jacketed/hard-cast lead, we can get away with having little case flare, just enough to accept the bullet. With plated, we can't. Thick plating helps some, but with little case flare it's still quite possible for an under-

flared case mouth to cut through the plating. We'll actually get a "smear" of plating where it's been cut through and pushed back along the side of the bullet. Not only does this lead to horrible accuracy, it can actually cause the bullet to be so oversized it won't even chamber.

Check out the photos of damage caused to plated bullets from too little case mouth flare. Also check the photo of how much I flare casings with my Dillon RL 650 and both my Square Deals. For those not used to loading plated bullets, this might seem a bit extreme. For plated bullets it's absolutely necessary. Be careful, we don't want to overdo it to the point it's difficult to fit casings into the machine's other dies after flaring, or drive the "opened up" portion so far down into the casing we've comprised resizing, because, as we're about to discuss, resizing is necessary to prevent bullet setback when actually firing the gun. There is a very definite "it's enough, it's not too much" point we want to reach here.

CRIMP


If there's one error most handloaders make, especially when loading autopistol cartridges, it's over-crimping. Okay, we all know we taper crimp autopistol cartridges instead of roll crimping, as we would with a revolver cartridge. But it's quite possible to overdo it, even with a taper crimp.

There is a myth, and I assure you, it is a myth, that we need a tight taper crimp to prevent the bullet from being shoved back into the casing when it hits an autopistol's feed ramp. This is false. It's not the crimp that prevents bullet setback, it's a

combination of (a) bullet sides-to-case wall friction, (b) resizing the casing, and the fact that, when the bullet is sitting inside the casing, it's pushed the case walls out wider than their resized width, for the depth of the bullet, but under that the casing is still sized tighter than the bullet diameter, therefore the bullet sits on a "shelf" with brass coming around and underneath the sides of its base, all the way around.

Depending on exactly how much crimp is applied (the people whose mantra is "make it look like a Coke bottle"), it can actually deform brass so severely it causes the casing along the sides of and UNDER the bullet to bow outward. This destroys or at least severely lessens the "shelf" effect, as well as the bullet sides-to-case wall friction also necessary to prevent bullet setback, making it MORE likely the bullet will be driven backward in the casing during autopistol feeding, not less.

Over-crimping will deform even jacketed or hard-cast lead bullets, degrading accuracy. More to the point with plated bullets, again bear in mind the plating's relative thinness, therefore its fragility. We need to respect that. Over-crimp, and it is guite possible for the sharp case mouth to cut through the plating, down into lead, all the way around the circumference of the bullet. Even if it doesn't cut in quite that far, we can still weaken the plating to the point we wind up stripping the rear of the bullet plating (the "rear cup," as I call it) off the bullet, in the bore. If that happens in the bore, best case - you'll notice decreased accuracy, worst case - guns have reportedly blown up. However, if the rear cup strips in the chamber when the bullet hits the rifling after firing, you can actually get a failure to feed/failure to go into battery as your gun tries


to stuff a loaded round into a chamber blocked at its front with a stripped rear cup.

We want our crimp to simply straighten out case flare without cutting into the bullet plating, period. Literally, if we were to pull a bullet, we would want to see no "ring" at all. Typical advice on how to set crimp goes like this: "Take the bullet diameter, measure the width of the casing wall at the mouth with dial calipers, double that number and add it to the bullet diameter." This gives us a number to which, theoretically, we're supposed to set the case mouth diameter of loaded rounds. Then we measure the diameter of a loaded round, right at the mouth, right at the crimp, to make sure we've done that.

There are multiple problems with this approach. For one thing, it ignores the fact that, in 9mm especially, case wall thickness varies immensely between makers. "No problem," our here's-the-magic-number fans say, "just sort casings and use all the same brand." Yeah. And every time I switch to a different brand of casing, I'm supposed to measure the case walls, and mess with my crimp die, and reset the crimp diameter of loaded rounds, right? That's a lot of tedious work. Thank you, no.

Also, if you can honestly hold a round of loaded ammo in one hand, and a set of dial calipers in the other, so steadily in relationship to each other you can get the jaws of the caliper riiiiiight on the case mouth, at the crimp, and hold it there long enough to measure diameter, all I can say is you obviously have better hand/eye coordination than I do.

I needed a way to set the crimp that would (a) simply remove flare but not cut into plated bullets, (b) work across multiple brands of casings, because



I don't sort casings, I'm a total range vacuum and use a lot of "pick up brass." What I eventually came up with is this: I use a case gage to set crimp.

A case gage is a round sided, flat topped and bottomed piece of metal, usually stainless steel, that's had drilled into it, longitudinally, a hole equivalent to an extremely tight match chamber for a particular cartridge. If a loaded round will fit into the gage, it'll fit into a real gun's chamber. In this case (pun intended) however, we can take advantage of that fact and use the gage to set our autopistol taper crimp.

To start with, turn a casing backward and insert its rim into the gage, make sure the case rim will actually fit into the gage. Again in 9mm, diameter of rims varies hugely. It's not at all uncommon to have loaded rounds, even those that otherwise fit into the gage, bottom out on the rim and fail to fully seat. If a loaded round will not go into the gage when we're using it to set crimp, we want to know that's being caused by the case mouth, not the rim.

Back out the crimp die on your loading machine to the point it's not really doing anything. Insert your "I checked and its rim will fit into the gage" casing into the machine, resize it, flare the case mouth (you can even drop a powder charge, and when you've completed this process you'll have a fully reloaded, fireable cartridge), insert a bullet, and seat it. Then at the crimp station begin incrementally, minutely tightening the die. Between every tiny, partial turn, remove the car-

tridge from the machine and try to insert it into the gage. When it fails the gage, tighten down the crimp die a micro-turn, stick the cartridge back into the machine, crank the handle, then remove the round from the machine, try it again in the gage. This is a very exacting thing. As you begin applying more and more crimp, the cartridge begins fitting into the gage farther and farther. Eventually it will begin seating all the way but won't fall free when you upend the gage, the case mouth is still a bit too big. Keep applying little micro-turns, until the cartridge will both drop in smoothly and easily AND fall out of the gage when you turn it upside down.

Congratulations, you have just completely removed the flare from the case mouth, however you've done that to the absolute minimum necessary, without cutting into your plated bullets even a bit, and this will be true no matter the wall thickness of any casing you use.

And that's how you load accurate plated bullet ammo: choose the right bullet, flare the case mouth more than you would when using jacketed or hard cast lead, remove case flare without overcrimping. It's actually pretty simple, once you know how. Now that I've done the work for you – and this took a LOT of experimentation – you don't have to do it, yourself. So now you can get to it, and load some accurate plated rounds.

The Spandau in Gr

Long ago and far away, when JFK was in the White House, I was the only kid in town with a machine gun in the basement. Well, not, actually, in my own basement, but in what we called the Dillon family gun vault, arsenal, and firearms "lending library," across town in Grandma's basement. Its existence was an open secret, at least within my family and a small circle of friends. Back in those years before Vietnam, before domestic terrorism, and before, as the older folks used to say, "the inmates began running the American asylum," having a machine gun in the basement was no big deal. After all, similar machine guns, cemented to plinths, and painted Rust-o-leum black, were mounted outside more than a few VFW posts throughout America. An independent exterminator in Marin County, California, even had one welded to the roof of his pickup truck as a unique and unmistakable advertisement for his business.

The Dillon family machine gun was a war trophy, one of hundreds of identical WWI "bringbacks." It was an historical artifact, a testament to our own superiority over the supposedly unstoppable German War machine in 1918. My grandfather's 20 years as a combat solider in America, Asia, and Africa culminated with his service on the Western Front in the Great War. In command of both French and American forces, he dispatched large numbers of the Boche to the nether regions, and in turn survived being WIA, badly mustardgassed. Who would ever consider questioning his right to a few keepsakes from the recently vanguished foe? In any case, in 1919, when he dropped off the German Spandau machine gun in Sausalito, California, private ownership of fully automatic weapons was perfectly legal.

The gun came to California amidst the many tons of German war loot Grandpa Dillon brought back to the U.S. as noted in an earlier issue of *The*

Blue Press. Since he had delivered quite literally a shipload of captured German war booty to the Smithsonian Institution at General Pershing's request, there was no official objection to his keeping one or two duplicates of the hundreds of identical examples entrusted to our nation's primary museum, where, as it would eventuate, they were never actually put on display. Instead, all of the war booty Grandpa Dillon had collected over a six-month period, then shepherded across the Atlantic to Washington, D.C., was left out in the open, in the rain and snow, neglected for many years. Finally, it was thrown away by government employees during one of the post-WWI anti-military paroxysms that swept our country, the kind that also eliminated many army bases as well.

The machine gun in Grandma's basement was a Maxim Model 08/15, chambered for the superlative German military round, 8mm Mauser. It was the lighter, much more portable younger brother of the venerable old Model 1908 – the Maschinegewehr 08 – monster. This earlier weapon was the first machine gun to be massproduced for the Kaiser's army, after a number of experimental models, from 1896 through 1902, had been accepted in small numbers. Trial use of these first guns had resulted in modifications and improvements specified for the big, heavy, Model 1908 as the standard German machine gun. The MG 08 was more like a small, stationary, artillery piece than an infantry support weapon. It weighed in at over 150 lbs. with base and full water jacket. The gun was moved around after lifting onto a small, wheeled cart, pulled by horse, man and even dog power.

The original design was the brainchild of Hiram Maxim (1840-1916), the American inventor and electrical and mechanical engineer who moved to England in 1881, eventually (in 1900) becoming a naturalized Briton, and shortly thereafter (in 1901) knighted by King Edward VII. Prin-

cipally famous as one of the premier "merchants of death," Maxim's machine gun was only one of his many dozens of brilliant inventions, from the automatic fire sprinkler, to the light bulb, Thomas Alva Edison notwithstanding. Maxim began tinkering with recoil, gas and blowback, all three now standard self-loading methods, in the early 1880s. He began to patent his ideas in this field by 1883, and had developed the first practical machine gun by 1884. Critical to the success of his design were cooling via a water jacket and continuous belt feed, two concessions to efficiency resisted by the French (with their Hotchkiss), through WWI, and by the Japanese (with their Nambu) through WWII, both being stick-fed, air-cooled, alternatives.

An early proponent and inventor of smokeless powder, Maxim's self-loading gun would not become truly practical until black powder was superseded by smokeless in the 1890s. As early as 1893, however, British troops were slaughtering Matabeles in southern Africa with early Maxim guns. The inventor persuaded Edward Vickers to finance production of his weapon, with the result that it would forever after be called the Vickers machine gun. Eager to sell his idea to all comers, Maxim's machine gun was adopted by the Russian army, and, according to popular mythology, was responsible for at least half of the Japanese casualties inflicted by the Czar's troops during the Russo-Japanese War of 1904-05. And, of course, Maxim also sold his design to the Germans, who, in World War I, using both the MG 08 and 08/15, killed just as many Tommies as did British troops firing Maxim's Vickers guns kill Teutons. Maxim's "Devil's Paintbrush" was used by both sides for more than four years, and splashed the Western Front with the blood of millions of victims.

Weighing just under 40 pounds, the MG 08/15 was called by most American Doughboys the Spandau machine gun, after the arsenal at which most of them were made. This name was prominent atop its receiver. Instead of the MG 08's artillery-like base, weighing more (85 lbs.) than the gun itself, the new MG 08/15 variant had a light bipod on a flat swivel, simplifying rapid traversing. The new gun had a pistol grip and conventional trigger inside a trigger guard, and a weird, "Buck Rogers" type shoulder stock, unlike the twin vertical parallel rear "jack hammer" handles and thumb-trigger of the 60-pound MG 08. The 08's blocky, rectangular receiver was also "stepped-down" for the 08/15, the new sigmoidshaped receiver another concession to lighter weight. By the end of WWI more than 130,000 of the newer gun had been produced, most of them by the Spandau Arsenal.

Both guns were supplied by a fabric belt, containing 250 rounds, from a wooden feed box set on the ground adjacent to the gun: this belt was guided by the assistant gunner. The 08/15 guns, by 1918, could also be fitted with a 50- or 100-round enclosed belt container, and most guns made after 1916 had a slot in the stock and a bracket under the cooling jacket to receive a leather sling so that they could be carried across no-man's land and fired while in transit. Walk-around weight, with belt container attached and water jacket full, was over 50 lbs. Many were employed in just this fashion during the great German Spring 1918 offensive, which probably would have rolled up the weary and demoralized French and British forces during this fourth year of war were it not for the timely arrival of hundreds of thousands of American troops, who finally tipped the balance in favor of the allies. Meanwhile, the 08/15 was further modified, beginning in 1916, for fixed aerial applications, an improvement over the heavier model 08, both machine guns fitted with the interrupter gear allowing the pursuit pilot to fire through the arc of his own propeller, simply aiming the entire airplane at his opponent. First singly, then in pairs, the air-cooled versions were fed by long, 500-round belts.

Spandau MG 08/15s ended up in the strangest places after WWI. Hundreds were brought home as veteran's trophies to America, Canada, Australia, New Zealand and South Africa. The few that made their way to England mostly ended up in museums. Many examples captured by the French entered French Army stocks as reserve weapons, or were sent to French colonies in Africa and Indochina between the wars. And many surviving guns in Germany ended up in China in the late 1920s and early 1930s, as German advisors trained and equipped the Nationalist Chinese Army. Other survivors in Germany were re-used in WWII, mostly in home-defense situations. Then, in 1945, and on into the early Postwar period, many such guns were confiscated by the Red Army and later given by Russian Communists to their "revolutionary" comrades, including but not limited to the Red Chinese, North Koreans and Viet Cong. Other Spandau machine guns traveled an even more tortuous path, first captured by French occupation forces in Germany after WWI, then sent to French Indochina between the wars, then surrendered to the Japanese during their occupation of Vietnam during World War II, then captured yet again for the third time by the Viet Minh in 1945-46. Some of these old guns were even captured a fourth time, by American forces from Viet Cong or NVA units, as late as the early 1970s.

Back in 1919, not only was owning your own private machine gun perfectly legal, depending upon the dictates of the lowest level of local law enforcement, but by the 1920s you could also order full-auto weapons, most commonly the Thompson Submachine Gun, through the U.S. Mail. The Sausalito Chief of Police knew all about the Dillon family machine gun, and had no objection to it. His attitude was no doubt influenced, by 1932, by the fact that my Uncle Bill, the oldest of the four Dillon boys, within whose house the weapon resided, was now a Sausalito city cop. Full-auto ownership in America remained legal and uncomplicated into the early 1930s, when Federal law finally mandated the registration of machine guns through the National Firearms Act of 1934. You could still

own one, but only after formally registering it and by paying an onerous tax of \$200 per weapon – the cost of a good used car at the time. Many owners of "bring back" trophies rendered their guns inoperable, thus avoiding the tax, and kept them unregistered. Typical methods of making functional machine guns inoperable were pouring molten lead down the barrel, opening the fuzee cover and then welding

internal parts to each other, or, most simply, by selective removal of essential parts.

At some point after the passage of the 1934 law, and probably on the advice of his son Bill Dillon, who by that time had become a California State Policeman, my grandfather rendered his Spandau 08/15 inoperable by pulling the firingpin block (termed by some the "lock"). He neutralized the gun by the simple expedient of walking down Johnson Street and throwing this critical part into San Francisco Bay. He probably did this sometime between 1936 and 1938. By then the youngest of the four Dillon boys, my Dad, considered it great fun to dress up in one of the WWI German uniforms lying around the house (the Dillon house was crammed full of war trophies from the Western front, the Mexican Border, China, and the Philippines) lug the old

machine gun out into the back yard, and re-enact scenes from *All Quiet on the Western Front*, the premier WWI novel written from the German side. So the family machine gun remained unregistered, still legal, but inoperable.

It continued so for another eight or ten years, until another one of the four Dillon boys, my Uncle Jack, a Mustang Lieutenant Colonel in Korea shortly after the Japanese surrender in 1946, found an identical 08/15 machine gun during his weekly arms round-up and inventory. Weapons were confiscated both from surrendering Japanese troops trying to get home to Dai Nippon, and also from Communist infiltrators from what would become Red China only three years later, so this Korean Spandau could have come from almost anywhere. Uncle Jack, of course, pulled the firing-pin block from this gun, and mailed it home to

Sausalito. So after a 10-year "legal" interlude, the Dillon family machine gun was made whole once again.

once again. And so it staved for the next 15 years, until, in 1961, at age eight, I took it across town. laid it out over newspapers on my bedroom floor, and field stripped it. I disassembled it as far as I could. oiled all of the moving parts, rubbed off most of the rust with latigo leather, reassembled it,

and stood it in the corner of my room, where it became the envy of all of my friends and agemates who visited that week. Then, back to Grandma's basement it went, once I exchanged it for another gun to take apart the following week.

Another decade went by, while the entire country became divided between liberals and conservatives, their points of disagreement the Vietnam War and the function of the American military. This split was reflected within my own family. At one point my very nervous, liberal mother, alladither, asked my much more conservative combatveteran Dad what might happen if some neighbor "ratted us out" and the FBI became aware of the Dillon family machine gun. "What are you afraid of," Dad responded, "that somebody will tell my brother Bill?" For Uncle Bill, having gone from Sausalito city cop, to California State Policeman,

had finally, in 1936, become an FBI agent. Bill Dillon had known about his own Dad's machine gun since he was eight years old, and was monumentally unconcerned about its presence in his late mother's basement. But the 1968 Gun Control Act, a belated response to the Kennedy Assassination, further tightened restrictions on the ownership, and especially the transportation and transfer, of fully automatic weapons. A general "amnesty" for registering previously unregistered machine guns was ignored by many (like Uncle Bill), misunderstood by many more, and mistrusted by most (including my Uncle Jack).

By the early 1970s, whenever the subject of the machine gun in the basement came up between the four adult Dillon brothers, all deferred to my Uncle Bill, the oldest, who by then had retired from the FBI. He did not want to register the gun, for he had moved to Idaho, and did not want it. Uncle Jack, by then an inactive U.S. Army Colonel, wanted to keep it, and thought it was just fine where it was. But my mother's constant carping finally wore both him and my Dad down, who, after weathering her complaints for around a dozen years, decided to donate the old WWI Spandau to the San Francisco Presidio Museum. After all, Grandpa Dillon had not only served there, but his family had lived there before, during, and even after WWI. The plan sounded good: instead of being locked away, essentially in hiding, we could now share it with a wider and more appreciative audience. And, for that matter, visit it any time we wanted to. So, the Presidio, the oldest continuously operating military base in the country, seemed the most appropriate place for the old machine gun that had been in our family's care for more than half a century. I had no say in the matter, being in Central America at the time.

So, the Dillon family machine gun was duly presented to the Presidio Museum, with no questions asked. Unfortunately, it only stayed there for about a month, until somebody climbed up on the roof of the building, broke through a glass skylight, and stole our old Spandau right out of the museum. So much for doing the "right thing" in California, where no good deed ever goes unpunished. The machine gun in Grandma's basement was the "one that got away" from us, and has been MIA now for more than 40 years. Was it confiscated from the original thieves, or from some other equally dishonest receiver, and ultimately destroyed by law enforcement? Or was it sold to a legitimate collector under false pretenses, or, most likely, was it "parted out" for sale as separate parts by an unscrupulous vendor? All that remains of the machine gun that used to reside in Grandma's basement are the few photos we have of it, and my own memories of the week it spent in my bedroom, way back in 1961, during a comparatively uncomplicated time of our nation's history.
